
Merit Awards

Library Sessions

We are looking forward to welcoming parents to library sessions. These are an opportunity for you to choose a library book with your child in the morning when you drop off. Parents can go to their child's class through the entrance the children usually go in through. There will be a member of staff by the entrance and you will be asked to sign in.



The idea is that we continue to promote a love of reading and books with our children and offer parent the opportunity to choose a book with their child. Parents can attend any sessions they can and please do not worry if you cannot attend all of them as there will be lots of opportunities over the academic year.

Thank you to parents for sharing your ideas. Next term, we intend to change the days of the library sessions for each year group so that parents that are unable to attend this term, will hopefully get the opportunity to pop in during drop off in the Spring or Summer term.

Our first curriculum event (a longer parent session in school) is for KS1 parents and will be focused around reading. More details below!

KS1 Reading Curriculum Event

Thank you to Mrs Williams, who is organising our first curriculum event for parents on Thursday 16th September. The focus will be on reading. Parents of pupils in Y1 and Y2 will have the opportunity to come into school to spend some time in class watching the children during a phonics session and find out a bit more about how we teach phonics and reading at Violet Way during a presentation from Mrs Williams. There is also a chance to find out ways in which you can support your child at home with reading, including how to use our new online Reading Diaries through our MarvellousMe app.



Year 1 parents can sign into the office after drop off then go into class with their child from 9am. They will then attend a meeting in the hall at 9.30am. Year 2 parents can attend a meeting in the hall at 9.30am then go into class with their child after this session.

We hope you are able to attend but if not, please don't worry, we will be posting the presentation slides on our website.

There will be further curriculum events planned during the academic year and we will aim to give parents as much notice as possible.



Parent and Toddler Group

We are planning to start our Parent and Toddler session on Tuesday mornings for parents with preschool children. These ran very successfully prior to the Covid disruption. Mrs Kee has met with Mrs Jo Smith, who runs the sessions, to ensure the risk assessments have been completed and confirm the session times.

The sessions will run 9:00am-10:30am every Tuesday at a cost of £2.00 per family. The first session will be on Tuesday 21st September. Please go to the side entrance by the steps (adjacent to the sports court). The catering team will supply a plate of fruit and juice for the children and there will be hot drinks and toast available for purchase.
