Reception Information Autumn Term

Please find below some information about your child's first term in Reception:

Marvellous Me:

We will now be using Marvellous Me as our main form of communication with you. We can send reminders and newsletters via this to keep you updated but parents can also see learning that takes place in class and praise and rewards your child receives through thumbs up and badges. These can be viewed via the Marvellous Me app. You should have had a letter with information about this and code about how to create your parents account any problems please contact the school office.

Uniform:

The children have looked so smart coming back to school in their uniform this week. Can we just remind you that if children do have pierced ears then studs only must be worn to school. Children must also not be wearing any nail varnish.

Drinks and snacks:

Please make sure that your child is bringing a named water bottle to school with them daily. During morning playtime the children have a snack to eat. Your child can have toast provided by school – this costs £21 for the Autumn Term and can be paid via Parent Pay. If children want to bring in their own snack they can bring fruit, vegetables, cereal bars, bread sticks etc. We ask that crisps and chocolate are not sent in for snacks.

Forest Schools:

Forest Schools will start next week and children will have a forest school afternoon every other week. On their forest school days children need to come to school dressed in their Violet Way polo shirt and jumper but wearing suitable outdoor trousers. Please make sure your child has a pair of wellies that fit in school with their name clearly written inside. These are to stay in school for the whole term. Reception Forest school days are the following for this term:

- **Foxes** Monday afternoons on: 20th September, 4th, 18th October 8th, 22nd November & 6th December
- **Badgers** Monday afternoons on: 27th September, 11th October 8th, 1st, 15th, 29th November & 13th December
- **Squirrels** Thursday afternoons on: 30th September, 14th October 4th, 18th November & 2nd, 16th December

P.E:

Children will have weekly P.E lessons in school. They will now get changed for P.E in school rather than coming into school wearing their P.E kit.
