Treasure / scavenger Hunt

Make your own treasure hunt around the garden or house. Write simple clues for the children to read and follow. Or write simple maths questions for them to find the correct answer.

Write out a simple list of items to find in a scavenger hunt for children to read. Add in numbers to make it more challenging. Get the children to make their own!

Create an Easter / Spring garden

Create an indoor Easter garden using things you collect from your own garden or find and make things from your house. Put in your own toys or make animals to live in them. Make up a story about your garden. Write a description. Draw a picture. Create Maths problems — relating to it.

Make up your own stories/ Books

Make your own Easter stories or fact files about Spring and Baby animals.

Make a cartoon strip about your favourite super hero.

Make your own board games

Create your own board game to play. Snakes and ladders, bingo, snap, happy families.

Make your own Lego Creationary game —
write down names of objects, places or animals and try making them with Lego.

Hold a Mad Hatters Tea party

Read or watch Alice in Wonderland. Write invites for toys or members of the family to come. Cook real or pretend food. Make hats, decorations and jokes for the party. Learn and recite some silly poems to read when you are there.

Word puzzles

How many words can you make using the letters EASTER? Play as a family.

Make up your own poem using the letters in EASTER.

How many words can you think of beginning with E?

Make a word search.

Shapes and patterns

Find shapes around the house and draw round them to make your own Easter Shape picture.

Make up a symmetrical egg or repeating pattern egg.

Make use of all the junk modelling to make your own creations. Talk about the shapes you have used.
