

#### A Message from Mrs Kee

Queen Elizabeth II is set to make history as the Platinum Jubilee is the first-ever such anniversary in England's and the United Kingdom's long history. The commemoration will mark the 70th anniversary of the accession of the Queen to the throne and so it is an important part of our children's history. This week's learning in school was about celebrating the Queen's life. The children found out facts about the Queen, plotted some important events of her life onto a timeline and created portraits of the Queen. They have worked hard to learn the National Anthem and enjoyed performing this, and a 60's inspired medley to parents on Thursday. On Wednesday, the children played 60's music on the keyboards as part of their music lesson.

On Friday morning we planted a sapling and buried a time capsule, which included a message from every child in school. We also had a street party and hung their home-made royal bunting and paper chains around the school. The children's painted stones were placed within the planting boxes around school where children had planted red, white and blue flowers. Instead of Merit assembly this week we had an OBE (Outstanding Best Endeavours) award presented to two children in each class. I have been utterly impressed with all the children's focus and attitude this week. Lots of children, inspired by their learning in school, have been continuing their learning at home. I have been thrilled to see some fantastic writing – thank you! It has been a busy half term and there is lots happening after the holiday too.
