Brewhouse Production: *IMPORTANT amendments to ticket sales*

We are so lucky that the Year 2 children are able to take part in a production in the Brewhouse again this year. By the end of next week a letter will be sent home letting you know what costume your child needs. There is an afternoon production starting at 1.30pm and an evening production starting at 6.30pm. Parents will need to bring children to the Brewhouse for the evening performance.

Tickets for this will go on sale on Monday 27th June at 4:30pm. Instead of selling tickets in person at school, we will be sending out a link to a Microsoft Form via MarvellousMe at the time advertised above, through which you will be able to order your tickets. Seats will be allocated on a first come first served basis, based on the responses to the Form. Tickets will cost £6.50 each and each family will be able to buy a maximum of 3 tickets per performance to ensure there are enough for everyone. If there are any spares after all families have received tickets, we will offer those out as a second sale.

Parents have indicated that they would like to purchase a DVD of the performance. As such, we have arranged for the Y2's Brewhouse production to be filmed and made into DVDs for you to purchase! These will cost £13 per DVD and will also be available to purchase on ParentPay from next week.
