



### A Message from Mrs Kee

On Tuesday this week, our school Governors visited for a tour of the school. We considered some of the elements of our Academy Improvement Plan that teachers are working on and could see evidence of effective questioning strategies, such as 'think, pair, share' and 'cold calling'. We have a Governing Body meeting next week and look forward to planning further Governor visits to school.

The children have really enjoyed the whole school focus on Fairy Tales. They have enjoyed listening to a range of fairy tales, acting them out, discussing characters and creating their own characters. 
